On January 19, 2024, this Court heard Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion for Attorneys' Fees, Costs,
 and Incentive Award (the "Motion") filed by Plaintiffs Stephanie Aberl, Diana Vasquez, and Shannon
 Custer ("Plaintiffs"). This Court reviewed the Motion and the supporting papers. As such, having reviewed
 the foregoing and based on the findings below, the Court found good cause to grant the unopposed Motion.

The requested attorneys' fees and costs in the amount of \$700,000 is fair and reasonable in light
of the nature of the case, Class Counsel's experience and efforts in prosecuting this Action,¹ and the
significant benefit obtained for Class Members. An Individual Settlement Award in the amount of \$2,500
to Plaintiffs is fair and reasonable in light of the risks in commencing this Action, and the time and effort
spent litigating this action as the class representatives.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

IT IS SO ORDERED.

Class Counsel is awarded attorneys' fees and costs in the total amount of \$700,000.
 Defendant must pay Class Counsel this amount no later than thirty (30) calendar days after the Effective
 Date of Settlement and upon receipt of the relevant Form W-9, as set forth in section 2.4 of the Settlement
 Agreement; and

Plaintiffs are each awarded an Individual Settlement Award in the amount of \$2,500.
 Defendant must pay Plaintiffs this amount no later than thirty (30) calendar days after the Effective Date
 of Settlement and upon receipt of the relevant Form W-9, as set forth in section 2.5 of the Settlement
 Agreement.
